Opportunity for unemployed non-EI

British Columbians 18 years of age or older

Eligibility for Job Options BC:

- Unemployed, non-EI British Columbians who are Landed Immigrants or Canadian Citizens and are not attending school
- A non-EI individual is one who has not established a regular Employment Insurance (EI) claim in the last three years; and, has not established a maternity or parental claim in the past five years
- Individuals who are most likely to benefit from long term job search help, supported work experience and follow-up support services

Program offers:

- Participants will have the opportunity to assess and map their career direction within the Langley areas.
- Identify and overcome their barriers to employment
- Prepare for new and immediate employment, or where appropriate further training.
- 6 weeks of group-based curriculum and activities, including the provision of supports such as assessment, Personal Development (Life Skills), Employability Skills, basic computer skills and Job Finding Skills. This phase will also include individual-based programming such as one-on-one counselling.
- Be provided training allowance for 6 weeks of group work
- After the 6 weeks of classroom programming, the participants will be moved into the second phase, which will consist of 4 weeks of more individual options based on the individuals needs, such as active job search, short term training and/or work experience.
- Following participation in the Program, participants will be employed, have increased skills and confidence to find employment, or will move into another employment intervention such as further training.
